mong the emotional symptoms* associated with post-abortion stress are:

- strong sense of guilt
- intense feelings of grief, sadness, loss
- nightmares and/or insomnia
- nervous breakdowns
- loss of confidence in decision making
- loss of self-esteem
- regret and remorse
- suicidal impulses
- self-hatred
- depression
- new or increased drug and/or alcohol abuse
- fear that you may never again be able to become pregnant
- fear that any succeeding child(ren) will in some way be deformed
- decreased ability to experience emotions
- inability to communicate
- fear that others will learn of the abortion
- fear that others will hate you if they learn of the abortion

If you recognize yourself in the above description, you are not alone. Many postaborted women and men have felt the same emotions.

There is hope. The healing process begins by contacting people who care and can help.
